Rules for the Young Researcher Prize

This document specifies the terms for the award of the Young Researcher Prize awarded every year to the best paper delivered during the TOTh conference.

Objective and theme

The purpose of the Young Researcher Prize is to acknowledge the scientific quality of the works of authors in the domain of terminology and ontology relating to the themes set out in the call for papers.

Eligibility

The authors must be :

- aged less than 35;
- working on a doctoral thesis or holders of a doctorate for less than 3 years.

Selection

Selection is based on submission evaluations by the TOTh International Scientific Committee. The principal evaluation criteria are based on the scientific quality of the work, its originality and potential, and on the quality of the writing.

The Prize

Award of the prize bestows the right to free participation in the conference and associated events the following year.

Terms of submission

Submission must specify the Young Researcher category

The terms of submission are identical to those of other submissions except that they should include the wording “Young Researcher Category” at the beginning of the paper. Authors will be asked for an attestation of registration in a thesis or viva.
